The JTF will broaden the conclusions developed in the three dedicated test areas by leveraging off of ADS activities sponsored and conducted by other agencies. The SIT consists of two phases. The first phase, the Linked Simulators Phase (LSP), has been completed and employed an all-simulator architecture for testing an AIM-9 Sidewinder missile. The second phase is now underway and links live shooter and target aircraft to an AIM-i 20 AMRAAM hardware-in-the-loop (HWIL) simulation at Eglin AFB.
