It was first endeavored to attain the necessary degree of stability without resorting to additional floats. This, however, proved impossible because of the large dimensions of the Do.X, unless considerable disadvantages were accepted. It was finally decided to adopt the stub wings which, for over ten years, have been successfully used in hundreds of cases.
