Some neoplasms, heretofore classified as lymphomas, now appear, from the results of penetrating analysis using newer methodology, to be malignancies of the macrophage series, rather than of the lymphocytic series. These neoplasms include Hodgkin's disease and a minority of neoplasms previously referred to as histiocytic lymphomas. The majority of these histiocytic lymphomas are now known to be lymphoid malignancies involving the B-cell series.
