The results in the training stage were (C4.5 gave 99.8664%, k-mean gave 97.7930%, k-medoid gave 97.3620% and ANN gave 96.538%). While in the testing stage we used three classifiers (Euclidian Distance, Modify of the Standardize Euclidian Distance and Correlation) and the results show that (Euclidian Distance gave 94.7368%, Modify of the Standardize Euclidian Distance gave 98.2456% and Correlation gave 96.4912%) We create our database (ten videos with 814 frames.

Robust Hand Gesture Recognition for Robotic Hand Control Ankit Chaudhary,2017-06-05 This book focuses on light invariant bare hand gesture recognition while there is no restriction on the types of gestures. Observations and results have confirmed that this research work can be used to remotely control a robotic hand using hand gestures. The system developed here is also able to recognize hand gestures in different lighting conditions. The preprocessing is performed by developing an image-cropping algorithm that ensures only the area of interest is included in the segmented image. The segmented image is compared with a predefined gesture set which must be installed in the recognition system. These images are stored and feature vectors are extracted from them. These feature vectors are subsequently presented using an orientation histogram, which provides a view of the edges in the form of frequency. Thereby, if the same gesture is shown twice in different lighting intensities, both repetitions will map to the same gesture in the stored data. The mapping of the segmented image's orientation histogram is firstly done using the Euclidian distance method. Secondly, the supervised neural network is trained for the same, producing better recognition results. An approach to controlling electro-mechanical robotic hands using dynamic hand gestures is also presented using a robot simulator. Such robotic hands have applications in commercial, military or emergency operations where human life cannot be risked. For such applications, an

artificial robotic hand is required to perform real-time operations. This robotic hand should be able to move its fingers in the same manner as a human hand. For this purpose, hand geometry parameters are obtained using a webcam and also using KINECT. The parameter detection is direction invariant in both methods. Once the hand parameters are obtained, the fingers' angle information is obtained by performing a geometrical analysis. An artificial neural network is also implemented to calculate the angles. These two methods can be used with only one hand, either right or left. A separate method that is applicable to both hands simultaneously is also developed and fingers angles are calculated. The contents of this book will be useful for researchers and professional engineers working on robotic arm/hand systems.

To explore the feasibility of incorporating communicative hand gestures in advanced upper limb prosthetics, we first need to understand the temporal relationship between speech and gesture. The focus of this thesis is to investigate the temporal synchrony between speech and gesture onset of healthy subjects, We defined 4 sets of gesture-word pair, which was used as the corpus of our study. 13 individuals were fitted with electrodes on 4 muscles on their forearm and were instructed to vocalise the predefined words in our corpus, whiles simultaneously performing the hand gesture associated with the vocalised word. A microphone was used to record subjects' vocal signals. Subjects performed repetitions of each gesture-word pair, whiles being prompted by an audio cue. To enhance spontaneity in speech and gesture of our subjects, we instructed them to perform the same number of repetitions of each gesture-word pair, this time at their own chosen pace. Muscle activity and audio data were collected in real time. Our results showed, in all instances of simultaneous speaking and gesturing analysed, that the onset of muscle activity, occurred before the onset of vocalisation. This proved to be consistent with other research into speech and gesturing synchrony. The EMG-speech onset time lag however differed between muscles, subjects and also the type of hand gesture being performed. We also found out that self-paced speech and gesturing had no significant effect on the temporal synchrony. Recommendations for future work include analysis EMG and speech interactions during natural conversation or free
