Getting Bergson Straight: The Contributions of Intuition to the Sciences Pete A.Y. Gunter,2023-04-25 This study concerns the ideas of one particular philosopher, Henri Bergson, whose views of time, intuition, and creativity have had a significant impact on art, literature, and the humanities, both in his time and in our own.
