companion arranged for me to stay with a Japanese family followed by touring Niko National Park. Traveling home on emergency leave was quite an episode! The remaining months of my active duty, I was reassigned to the Hospital Management Office at Fort Dix, New Jersey. March 22, 1957, I left active service and was automatically transferred into an inactive Army Reserve unit for six years. During that period the US faced a grave threat in Laos and seriously considered military intervention. I was notified to take a physical exam. I received my discharge from the Army Reserve and from the Armed Forces on February 28, 1963.
