We make an impassioned yet research-backed case for the power of assuming positive intent, and then provide the tools to follow it up: **Prove It's Safe:** make your appreciation for fearless communication explicit, jump in first by speaking vulnerably, and, if needed, rope off some small boundaries. **Dignify Every Try:** when your people start to speak up, dignify the slightest (or even most awkward) try. **Make a big deal of it.** **Be Genuinely Curious:** pocket your dynamite (a leader's tendency to dominate conversation), ask **Authentic Questions** (and then really listen), and draw in those who are normally overlooked (introverts and newcomers).
