Ultimately, Crowley didn't actually leave the Order, not as he described, but finished off his alienation of the group by publishing some of their secret documents. To add insult to injury, he wasn't just revealing secrets, but he was giving himself credit for works that Mathers had written. Crowley claimed to be doing it because Mathers was actually under the influence of the evil that he couldn't control. Lawsuits soon followed, but since Mathers hadn't copyrighted the works outside of the organization, Crowley won.⁸
