The keel of Graf Zeppelin was laid down the next year. Two years later, Grossadmiral (Grand Admiral) Erich Raeder presented an ambitious shipbuilding program called Plan Z, in which four carriers were to be built by 1945. In 1939, he revised the plan, reducing the number to two. The Kriegsmarine has always maintained a policy of not assigning a name to a ship until it is launched. The first German carrier,

Breaking these restrictions might require specific software or tools, which may or may not be legal depending on the circumstances and local

laws.
